

Role Title: Storm Team Manager

About Us:

Storm is Newfoundland and Labrador's junior provincial ultimate team. We provide athletes from the ages of 14-18 the opportunity to play competitive ultimate at away tournaments including the Canadian Ultimate Championships.

In 2024, Storm's open and women's teams aim to compete at the Junior Canadian Ultimate Championships (CUC) in Ottawa, Ontario from August 11-14, 2024.

Role Description:

We are seeking 2 dedicated and passionate individuals to join our team as a Team Managers (one for each of the open and women's teams). The ideal candidate will have a strong understanding of team sports, excellent organizational skills, and a desire to support the program. These positions report to the Storm Director and each team's coaches. This role includes working with/ managing parent volunteers. The intent is to provide logistical support throughout the season and to operate as team manager/ chaperone at tournaments.

Responsibilities:

- Assist Director with travel planning, booking, and organizing
- Assist with fundraising efforts and tracking
- Liaise with parents and athletes about season details
- Be available for questions about the program
- Work within allocated budgets and track spending
- Assist and facilitate parent/ coaches meeting
- Act as an administrative point of contact for parents and athletes
- Meet with coaches and Director monthly throughout the season (Mostly over zoom)
- Act as a chaperone for trips
- Work with chaperones to coordinate meals and ground transportation during tournaments.
- Be a driver of the team vehicle, used for team related errands and support during tournaments.



- Adhere to all Storm, UNL, and Ultimate Canada policies related to the role.
- Help advance the program with creative solutions

Ideal qualifications:

- Passion for team sports and providing team sport opportunities to youth.
- Strong organizational and time management skills.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work effectively in a team environment.
- Prior experience in coaching, managing, or playing ultimate frisbee is a plus.
- Required to undergo background checks.
