

Ultimate NL Junior Athlete Code of Conduct Agreement

Athletes representing Ultimate NL are expected to follow the Ultimate NL Athlete Code of Conduct Agreement listed below. Any athlete who violates this agreement is subject to, at the discretion of coach(s) / Ultimate NL, disciplinary action up to and including removal from the team/ program, or being sent home from a trip.

1. I will participate in Ultimate games, practices, events, and tournaments alcohol and drug free.
2. I will commit to attending all practices possible, except in the event of unavoidable conflicts or illness. I will communicate my absences with the team coaches. If my absences become significant and without excuse (a 3rd unexcused absence) my clear standing with the team may be in jeopardy.
3. I understand that equal playing time is not guaranteed and that attendance at practice will be considered when addressing playing time.
4. I will show respect for everyone involved in my Ultimate experience, including coaches, parents, teammates, observers, and spectators.
5. I will accept the decisions of coaches, observers, and other Ultimate NL board members. If I do not agree with the decisions of any of these parties, I will express them in a respectful manner and at an appropriate time.
6. Spirit of the Game (SOTG) / Rules Agreement:
 - a. I will agree to follow the Spirit of the Game. I will conduct myself in a manner that shows respect for the rules of the game and self-control. I will not use violence or crude language and will cooperate with my teammates and the opposing players to create a positive game experience.
 - b. I will remember that winning isn't everything and that having fun, improving skills, helping my teammates become better players, and doing my best are more important than winning games.
7. I will not engage in illegal conduct/ criminal activity, and am aware that any reports of involvement in such activity may result in disciplinary action from Ultimate NL.
8. As an Ultimate NL junior member, I will adhere to all other policies and regulations found through the [Ultimate NL website](#).
9. When agreeing to take part in an Ultimate NL junior program, such as the Storm NL Provincial Team, I acknowledge that I represent that program/ team at all times. I will strive

to honour that representation by adhering to policies, procedures, and rules set out by the staff (coaches, managers, and chaperones) of the program.

10. I will not act in a discriminatory or abusive way toward other players, coaches, chaperones, volunteers, etc. This includes, but is not limited to, wearing clothes exhibiting racist slogans or designs, playing vulgar, sexist, or racist music, using a discriminatory vocabulary, and harassment of any kind.

All individuals have a duty to report any violations of this code to the relevant Ultimate NL Board Director who will determine the necessary process for handling the report (eg. storm director, youth programming director, or schools director).
